Our National Capital Section is a cosponsor of this annual event.



### MARCH FOR SCIENCE

### SATURDAY APRIL 14

Our NCS membership is encouraged to participate in the April 14<sup>th</sup> "MARCH FOR SCIENCE" in Washington DC. This non-partisan event is sponsored by more than 100 other organizations, including the OSA. The march is intended to be a celebration of science focused on communicating the value of science to the larger community. Similar events will take place internationally. **PARKING:** Those familiar with UMD campus parking should note that conditions have changed. Construction around the AV Williams bldg. prevents parking adjacent to the Kim building. Prior to 4PM, there is paid visitor parking in the Regent's Garage (#2 in the Figure below), and in the metered Visitor's lot at \$3 per hour (# 1 in Figure). Afterward, our NCS/OSA will honor parking receipts for reimbursement. There is limited free parking after 4PM in the Regents Garage on entry Level B and lower Level RR; and free parking in lot 11b, a few blocks north of the AV Williams bldg. on Paint Branch Dr. *Please pay careful attention to lot signage as you enter to avoid possible ticketing*.


